### *Directions*



Visitors arriving can look for the landmark of colorful flowers on the side of the building, marking the entrance of the studio. The studio is behind the Fox Real Estate building, which is white with red signs/awnings. There's a restaurant, library and waterfront park within a quarter mile.

**From I-295 take exit 37** for Route 138/Route 125 toward Bowdoinham/Bowdoin. Turn right at Route 138 (follow signs for Bowdoinham); go straight past where 138 goes to the left, in order to stay on Route 125/Main St. Continue straight on Route 125/Main St.; turn left onto Center Street.

**Routes 201 and 24** intersect with Main Street/Route 125. From Main St./Route 125, the turn onto Center Street is **one-tenth of a mile east of the waterfront/Route 24**, or a **mile west of exit 37**.
