Creative Movement for Science Lessons

An example of this kind of program is:

Life Cycles of Seeds and Butterflies

A movement piece with children working as a group while Hope provides a spoken narrative and fiddle music. We discuss the material, do movement warm-ups and group building, & learn simple interpretive choreography.



Story Dances

An example of this kind of program is:

The History of Bowdoinham

Learn about **local history** through **music and movement**, participating in the **creation & performance** of an original theater piece. Written and directed by Hope Hoffman, the show includes fiddle music and singing. **Choreographed and improvised** dances bring the story to life.



All with Live Fiddle Music

Programs can be developed around **themes** including **science**, the **arts**, the **natural world** & **local foods**.

The usual length of a program is **45 minutes**; the addition of Hope's brief lecture-demo about fiddle music can **extend the program to 60 minutes**. If your venue has more than one group of participants, the program can be arranged as two or three **consecutive sessions of 30 minutes** each.

For ages 5-10, and can be adapted for various age groups including preschool & middle school.

Hope Hoffman has been a freelance dance teacher since 1999 and a full-time performer including fiddle music since 2001. Her sessions of music and dance for children have been presented multiple times at the <u>Children's Museum of Maine</u> in Portland, <u>Curtis Memorial Library</u> in Brunswick, the <u>Maine Discovery Museum</u> in Bangor, and the <u>Long Island Children's Museum</u> in New York.
